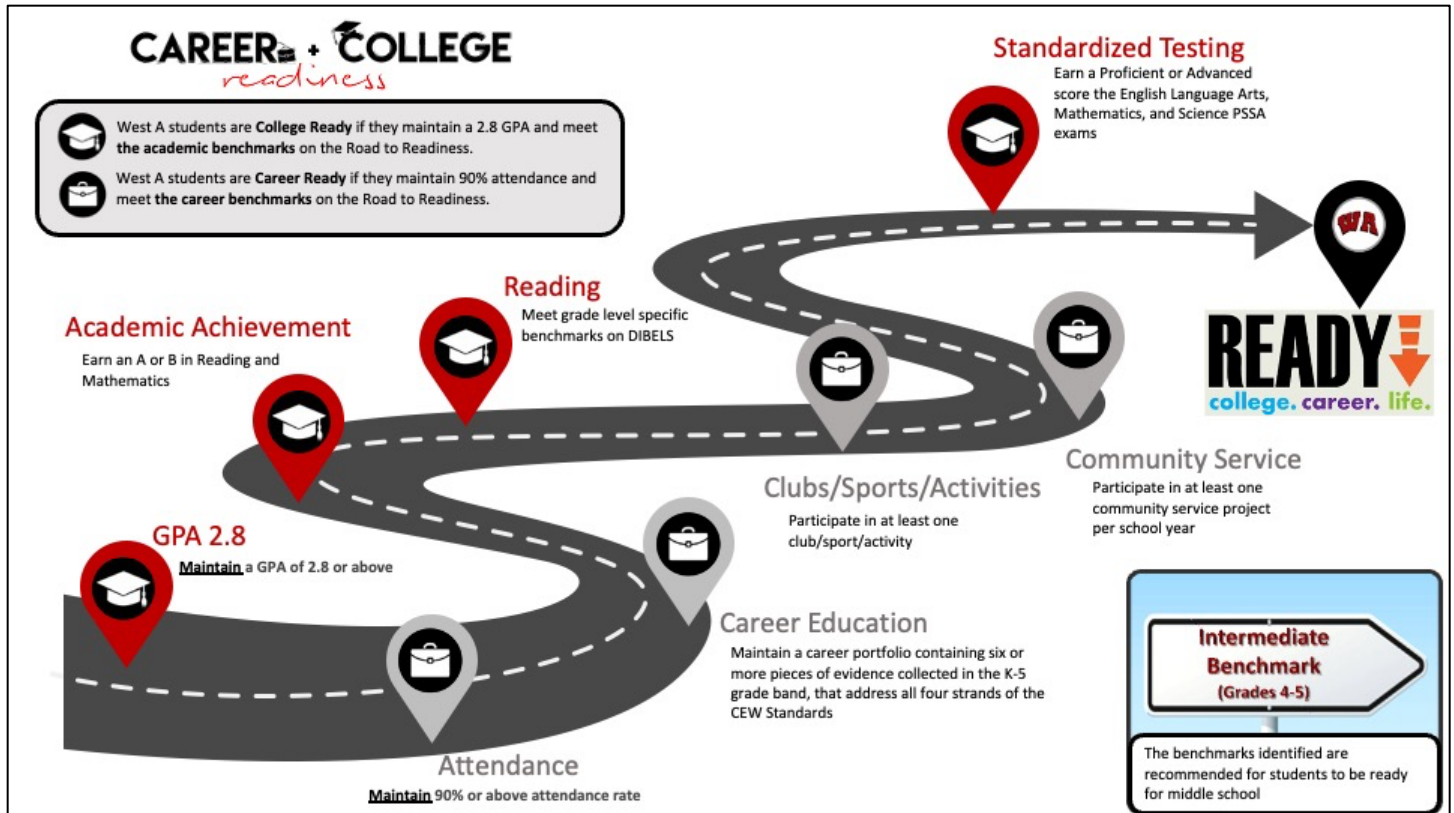
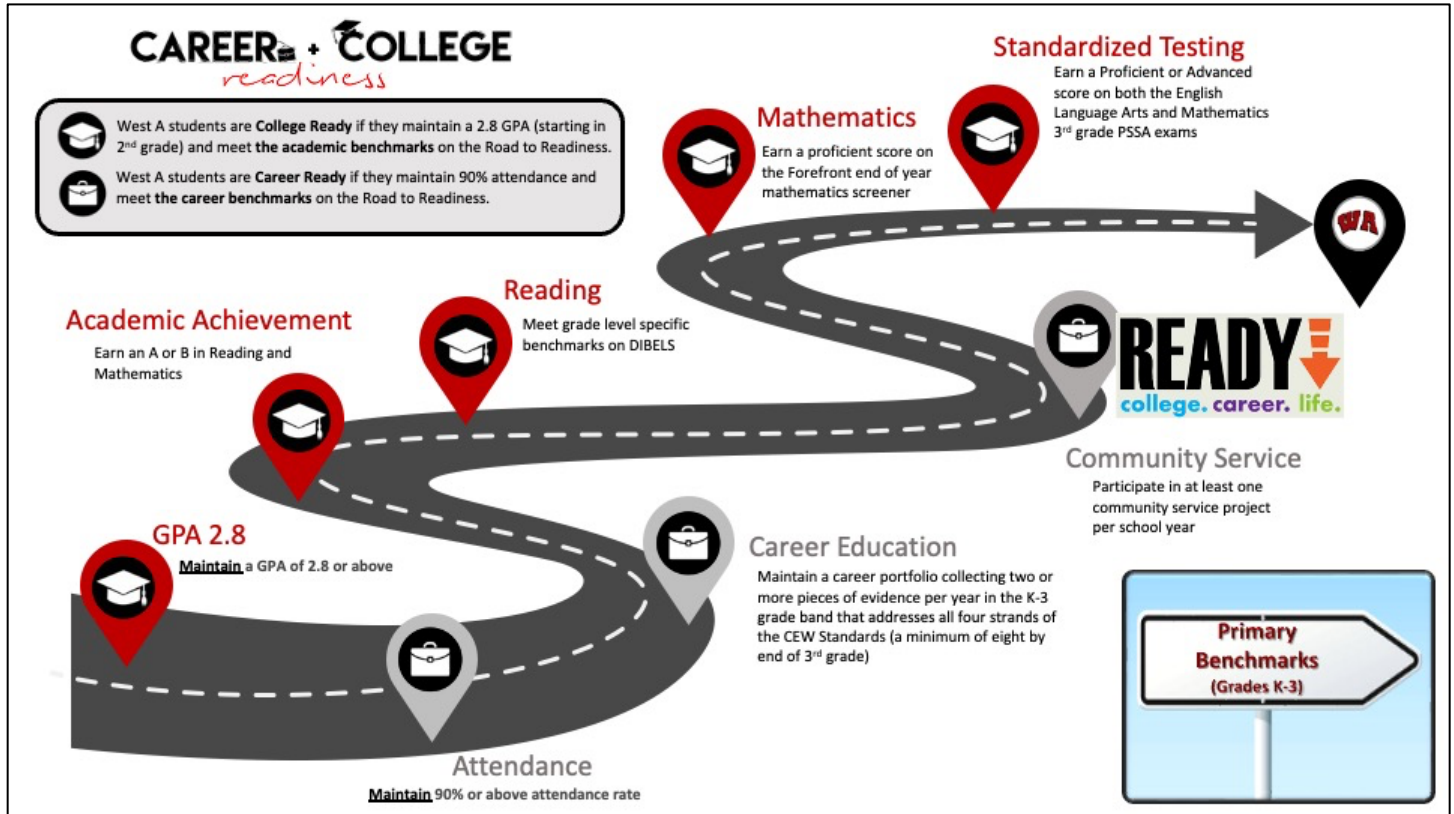
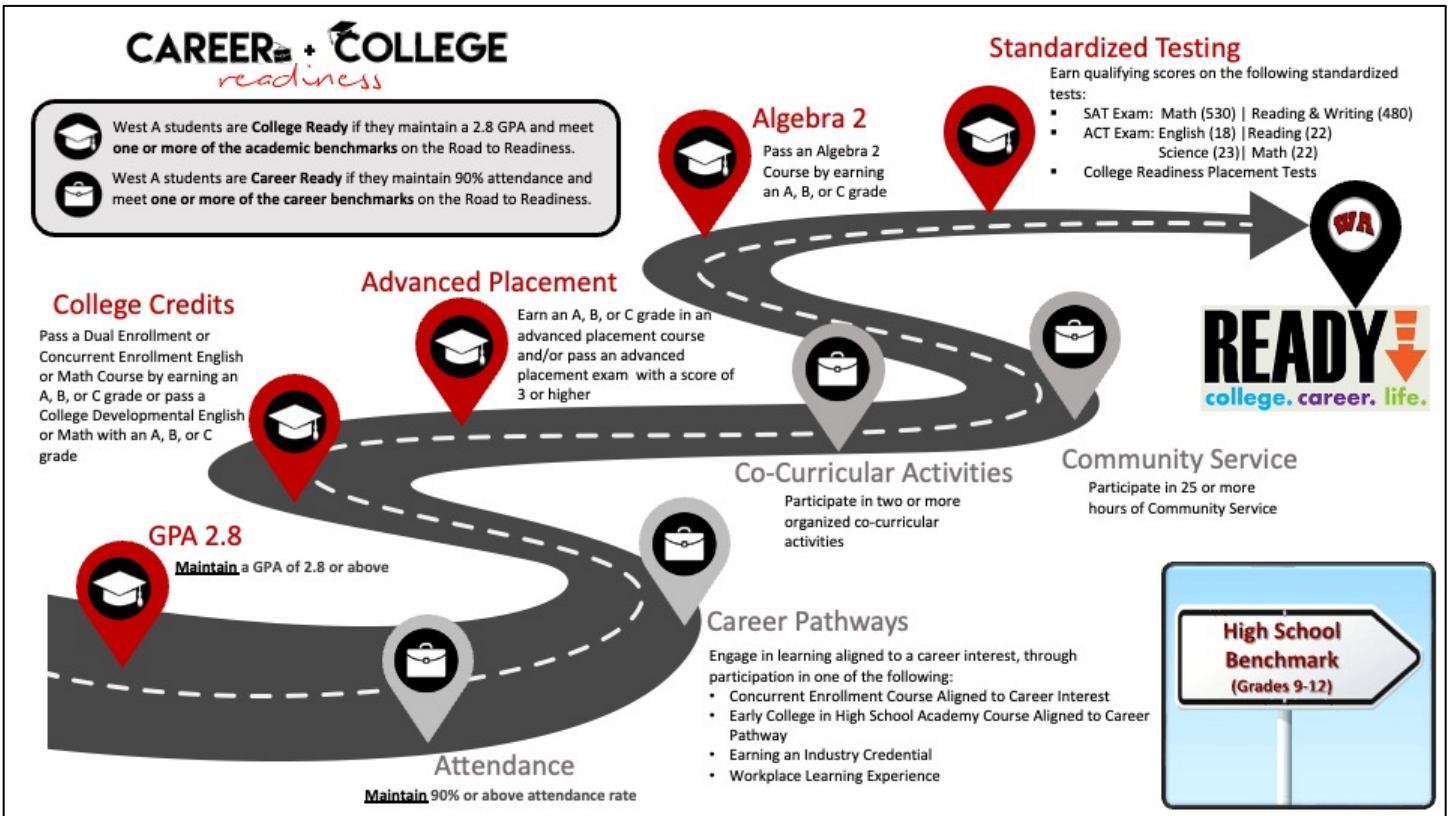
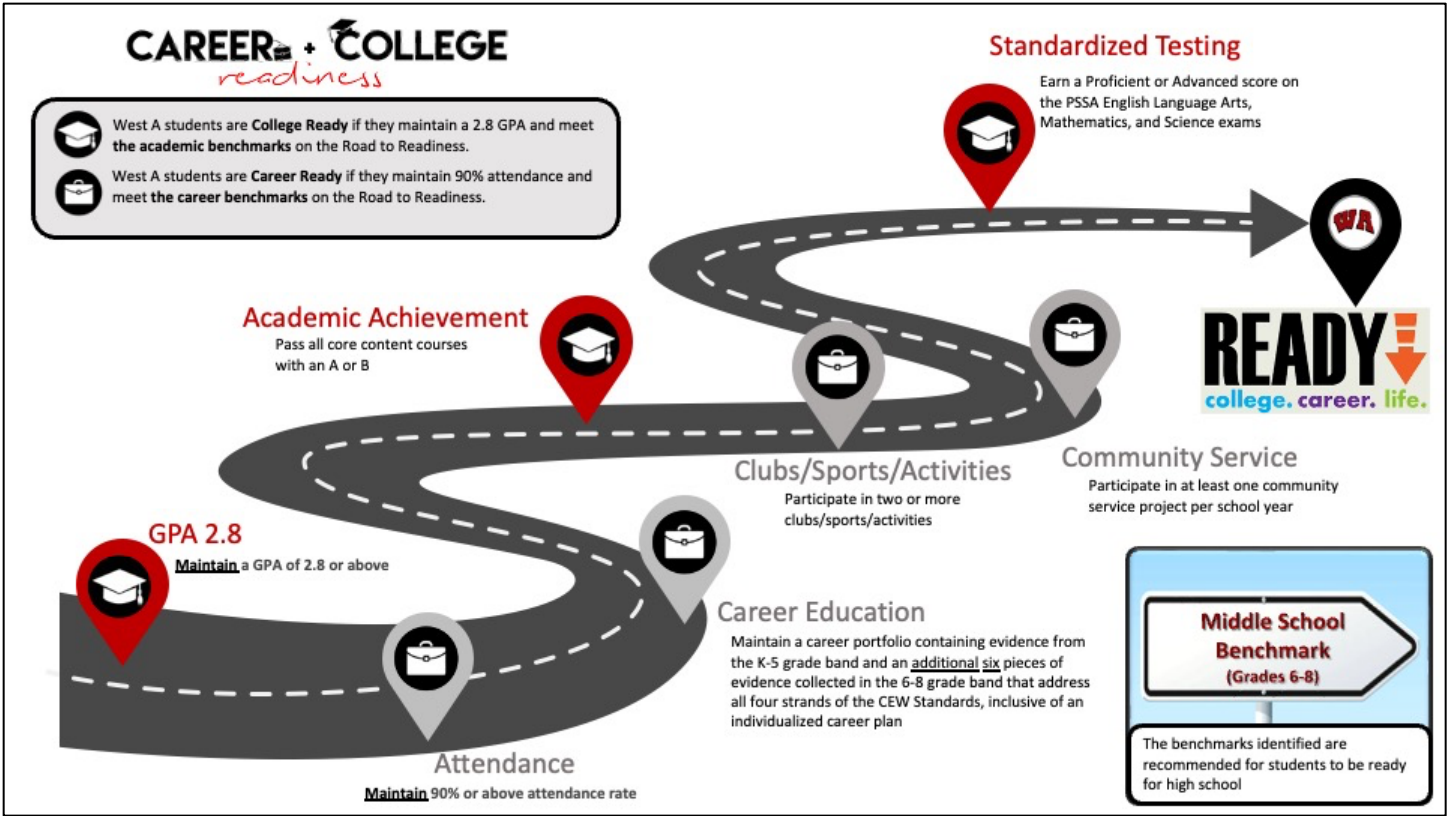


West Allegheny School District follows research-based indicators when supporting students at all grade levels. These indicators have been compiled to form our Road to Readiness with benchmarks for each grade band.
